1. Embrace safety as your personal responsibility
2. Implement, communicate, and adhere to best safety practices and standards
3. Work with EH&S and others to implement the systems, procedures, and tools for improved safety performance
4. Educate your direct reports about the benefits & expectations of upholding safety practices versus the risks of not
5. Engage and utilize the Chancellor's Leadership Group to develop and promote safety practices
6. Integrate safety into daily operations and individual job functions (Integrated Safety & Environmental Management System)
7. Provide your units and direct reports with the necessary communication, funding, and training resources to work, act, and be safe
8. Empower direct reports at all levels to take individual responsibility and action for safety
9. Recognize and reward direct reports for exemplary safety behavior through public praise and verbal acknowledgement
10. Identify and correct unsafe acts and conditions and apply accountability, as appropriate
